You will then be notified as to whether your grant application was approved or denied.

Once a grant claim has been approved by the supervisors, a check will be issued to the applicant by the County Clerk for the amount approved by the committee as agreed to by the Board of Supervisors. In order to satisfy audit requirements, copies of paid invoices from suppliers, contractors, etc., for your project or event, up to or exceeding the amount of the grant, <u>must</u> be provided to the committee within 45 days of project or event completion. 
